Sergeant Allison of Longview PD Receives Professional Achievement Award

The 2025 State of Texas Law Enforcement Achievement Award for Professional Achievement was awarded to Sergeant Drew Allison for his instrumental role in establishing the Longview Police Department as a regional training hub for ALERRT active shooter response. Through his leadership and commitment, training has been made accessible to over 50 agencies across Northeast Texas, including law enforcement, fire, and EMS personnel. His efforts have resulted in the successful delivery of over 60 end-user courses and 16 train-the-trainer classes, directly impacting more than 1,500 first responders.

In partnership with ALERRT, Sergeant Allison's work led to the completion of a Memorandum of Understanding officially establishing the Longview Police Department as the Northeast Texas ALERRT Training Hub.

Chief Bryan Pool has served as the Police Chief for the City of Overton since July 2021, following previous roles with the Henderson Police Department and Rusk County Sheriff's Office. He leads a team of five full-time officers, two part-time officers, and a
